





# EMERGENCY NUTRITION INTERVENTION FOR CHILDREN UNDER FIVE, ADOLESCENTS,

## **PREGNANT & LACTATING WOMEN (ENICAPLW)**

### September- 2019

- 4 A total of 23817 children under five and 8844 over five children were screened for malnutrition
- 431 children were identified with SAM, and consequently 272 children were referred to OTP.
- 4 1055 children were identified with MAM and subsequently 494 children were referred to TSFP.
- 4 A total of 258 new Pregnant and Lactating Women and 641 adolescent girls received 50876 Iron Folic Acid tablets
- 4 1035 boxes of MNP were provided to 144 beneficiaries and 83 beneficiaries received Albendazol.









At the age of 15 months child Nur Hasan was enrolled as SAM beneficiary at camp 2E in 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019. The baby was healthy at the time of admission. Noor was provided nutrition supplement through OTP as the regular basis. Nur's mother Rashida came to the OTP center on 19<sup>th</sup> August for the last time to take the nutrition supplement and at that time Nur had no physical complications. After that date, Nur was admitted in MSF with a severe illness. At the hospital, the child's family was informed that Nur was affected by the pneumonia. Inflammation of the liver begun when the pneumonia became a complex form and Nur Hassan died on 5<sup>th</sup> September.
