The Physiotherapist will be responsible for:

- Supporting assessment, fitting, and follow-up of assistive devices in coordination with P&O Technicians.
- Conducting home visits and supporting Activities of Daily Living (ADL) improvement.
- Providing caregiver guidance, awareness sessions, and basic counseling support.
- Maintaining case records, progress tracking, and reporting documentation.
